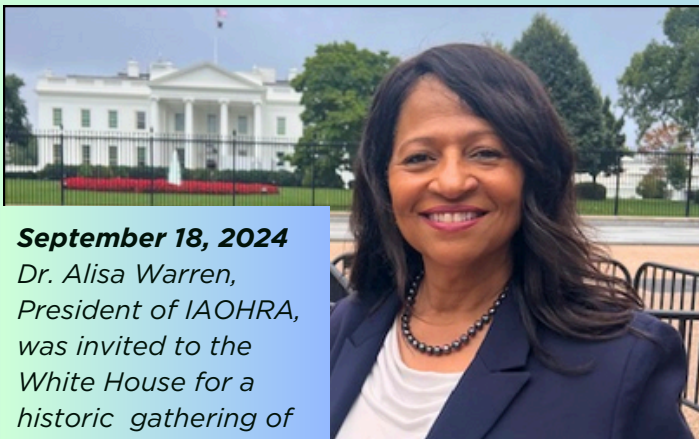

IAOHRA Goes to the White House



September 18, 2024

Dr. Alisa Warren, President of IAOHRA, was invited to the White House for a historic gathering of human rights leaders and members of Civil Society, which was followed by a press conference at the National Press Club in Washington, D.C. During her address, Dr. Warren reported on the urgent need for a National Human Rights Institute (NHRI) and urged the implementation of human rights treaties in the United States.



Dr. Warren addresses the White House Public Policy Council and key federal agency representatives on the critical need to establish an NHRI in the United States.

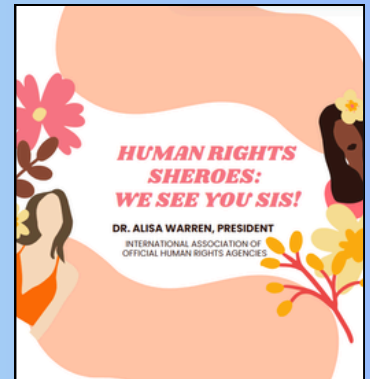

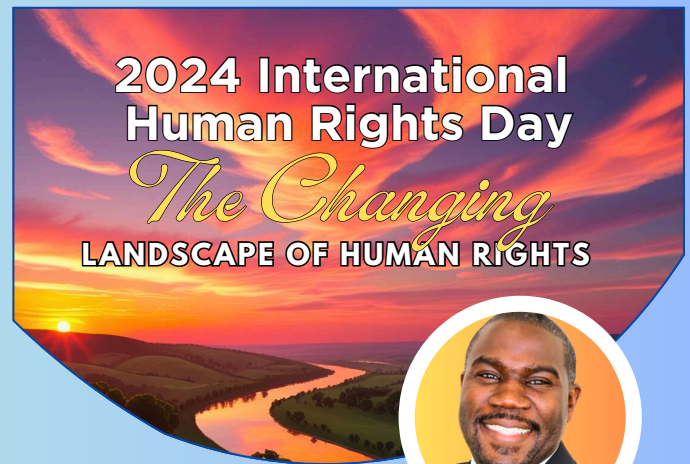
IAOHRA @ the Alaska Human Rights Conference
